In 2015, she started serialization in Tokyo newspaper. She was invited to European Capital of Cultural Mons.

In 2014, she was invited to the Lithuanian International Poetry Festival "DRUSKININKAI POETIC FALL". She performed at the gallery in Paris. She wrote poems for exhibition "mission Cosmos × Art" at the Museum of Contemporary Art Tokyo. A picture of her poem installation was published in the French magazine "stradda".

In 2013, she got a grant and she traveled Slovenia, Italy and Germany during one month. While in this trip she was writing one poem everyday. With those poems she made her fifth poetry book "The Room Without Neighbors".

In 2006, she graduated Tokyo Zokei University. Her gradation work awarded at the university.
