The Catcher in the void

Trying to see something that we cannot see, or trying to listen a sound we cannot hear.

At first, I was making super natural experiences ("occult science") to pursuit as an art. For example, I made a machine of poltergeist phenomena, with rotating a house and shooting video inside, then it makes daily objects fling back and forth.

On the other hand, when the earthquake happened in 2011, my point of view to see occult science, changed to physical problems in society. After the nuclear accident, there was a power cut of electricity in Tokyo because of the nuclear accident, and my art works couldn't turn it, then I couldn't exhibit my work. Before that, I was a punk boy who is dissident and dreamed a "Do It Yourself," but I realized that my art works are depended in institution like power plant and government.

Since then, I started to think about alternative energy. And started to make an electric generator by myself. For example, the piece "電力発電" is a electric generator which can make electricity by electric. It is an absurd machine like an uroboros eating himself, But I dream an infinity energy in this machine.

The perspective of invisible energy in my recent works is more mixed these two side.

I'm trying to see an energy physically but incomprehensible. Science and Occult can not devide. Sometimes we believe too much in science and we misunderstand that something unimaginable could happen. Peoples are eroded from something we can not see and we never thought it happens. We should't forget that science is made by imagination of human and we have the power to make it.

This is why I' m dive to the void.
