Fény was started in 1998 and has children ages 3 through 18. Currently we have about 90 members. "Fény" means "shiny" in Hungarian. We chose this name because it represents the attitude we have when singing. We practice six times each month, for about 2 hours each time. The children are all from the Tokorozawa City area, and come from many different schools.



Each year we do about 10 concerts. They range from small concerts at local retirement homes, to our annual Fény concert. We sing a mix of songs, mostly Japanese, English, or Hungarian.



We enjoy beautiful choral songs, so we try to form relationships with various countries and choirs. Fény has visited Hungary, Latvia, Poland, and Bulgaria, which were all great experiences for everyone who went. Also, in Japan, we've had Hungarian, Belgium, Bulgarian, Korean, Latvian and Russian choirs visit and have done joint concerts. This has been a wonderful opportunity for all Fény members to expand their view of the world.
