Shingo Yoshida (b. in 1974, Tokyo)

Yoshida received his MA with highest honors from Ecole Nationale Supérieure d'Art, Villa Arson in Nice France in 2004.

In 2005 he earned a post-graduate diploma at the Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Beaux-Arts de Lyon, France, and subsequently in 2007

he received another post-graduate diploma in the Program La Seine of Ecole Nationale Supérieure des BeauxArts de Paris.

He completed the prestigious international artist residencies at Villa Arson Nice France – and was awarded the Fellowship of Overseas Study Programme for Artists by the Agency for Cultural Affairs of the Japanese Government.

Yoshida's work has been shown in many international exhibitions, including: Palais de Tokyo, Paris ;

the Museo de Arte Contemporáneo MAC, Santiago, Chile; Arte tv Creative ;

Based in Berlin by Klaus Biesenbach, Christine Macel and Hans Ulrich Obrist.
