TAKUYA TANIGUCHI is Japan's No.1 Taiko player

- As Japan's No.1 Taiko player, TAKUYA calls himself a 'TAIKO-IST' because he is the master of Taiko.
- TAKUYA represents what Taiko can do. The sounds of his Taiko are the true Taiko sounds, developed through his training and discipline over 35 years.
- TAKUYA works as a dedicated musician/composer and his performance range is wide and various (Solo Ensemble Orchestra).
- TAKUYA creates the most thrilling moments with his passion towards Taiko.
- Taiko is TAKUYA's life and his journey will never end, as the sound of Taiko is like a human's heartbeat.

PROFILE

TAKUYA has been playing the Taiko from the age of three. At the age of 16, he founded a Taiko group called "TENRYU-DAIKO". In July 2002 he won a special prize at the "Viennese World Youth Music Festival" in Vienna. In 2003 he was accepted into his master Eitetsu Hayashi's ensemble called "FUUN-NO-KAI". Since he became a professional Taiko player, he has performed on many occasions such as: the International Taiko Festival Ecstasia, Tokyo Summer Music Festival 2004, a performance at the National Theatre in Tokyo with "KU-KAI-SEN-KYO" and many more exciting events throughout his career.

In 2011 TAKUYA moved to Germany and became a regular member of the German drum group called "Drumaturgia" and he has been on tour with the "World Percussion Ensemble" and Walter Lang across many cities in Europe and in Japan. In the past years, he has visited over 23 countries through his Taiko performances.
