

A music workshop artist who develops cutting-edge music workshops as a unique participatory music program. We hold music workshops and concerts that anyone can participate in regardless of age, language, or disability.

We have also participated in joint projects with overseas orchestras such as the London Symphony Orchestra and the BBC Symphony Orchestra.

Currently, 13 artists belong to the group, which has given about 300 performances, and more than 20,000 people from infants to adults have participated in its workshops.




