

# Tsuyoshi Matsumura - Profile

Tsuyoshi Matsumura is a Japanese composer and performer whose work explores the intersection of acoustic sound and electronic media. Beginning his musical training with the piano in early childhood, he gradually expanded his practice to include a wide range of instruments. His interest in contemporary and experimental music led him to pursue composition through self-study, cultivating a distinctive voice characterized by subtle textures, extended techniques, and cross-disciplinary influences.

In recent years, Matsumura has focused on performance formats that integrate live instruments with technology, such as cello with laptop processing and solo works for electronic organ. His practice often emphasizes the tension between physical gesture and digital abstraction.

He has collaborated with a variety of artists across genres, including notable figures such as Kenichi Takeda. In August 2023, he participated in the Blurborders International Performance Art Exchange - a cross-cultural platform for experimental performance art - presenting a live work that combined cello performance with real-time electronics and theatrical gesture.
